1. Outside pathology consultation status — Mayo Clinic Arizona

VERIFIED (2026-07-31) — Use the Mayo Clinic Arizona Department of Pathology numbers printed on Mayo's own consultation form (MCS14572): Mayo Clinic Arizona, Department of Pathology, 13400 East Shea Boulevard, Scottsdale, AZ 85259 — **(480) 301-8021** , and specifically "For Final Reports, call 480-301-8021"; non-billing questions can be directed to **480-301-6185**; billing questions to the Laboratory Billing Department at **800-447-6424** . Consult materials ship to that Scottsdale address; additional paperwork fax **480-301-9158**; a consult cannot be processed without a client account number (call **800-447-6424** if the sender has none).

Also verified route — if Intermountain/McKay-Dee sent it through Mayo Clinic Laboratories rather than direct to the AZ campus, the MCL line is **800-533-1710** (Mayo Clinic Laboratories telephone 800-533-1710 / 507-284-3156; hours Mon–Fri 8 a.m.–5 p.m. CT) . ⚠ Flag (VERIFIED from the form): the MCA form's available MCA consultation services are Breast, Gynecologic, Cytopathology, Hematopathology, Dermatopathology, Liver, Gastrointestinal, Pulmonary, Genitourinary, or "Other" — **bone/soft tissue (sarcoma) is not a listed MCA subspecialty**, so a sarcoma consult may have been logged as "Other" or routed to Rochester. Ask this explicitly on **480-301-8021**.

2. Mayo Clinic Arizona appointments

VERIFIED (2026-07-31) — Patients requesting an appointment at Mayo Clinic in Phoenix or Scottsdale, Arizona can call the Central Appointment Office at **480-301-8484**, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Mountain time, Monday through Friday . 3. Who may request status

UNVERIFIED (2026-07-31) — No Mayo page states whether a patient/family may phone for consult status. What Mayo pages *do* say, which implies an institution-driven process: a client account number is mandatory, and the form requires a designated institutional contact — "typically someone who can provide information instead of contacting the physician, such as a Medical Practice Secretary or administrative assistant" , and results/billing reporting depends on that account number . MCL also states it can, by law, only release reports on tests

performed at Mayo Clinic Laboratories, and patients must submit an authorization form . Practical read: status should be chased by McKay-Dee/Intermountain pathology (quoting CLS-24-094710 / order 730260012); the family's own verified route is the release-of-information path in item 5. 4. Turnaround

VERIFIED (2026-07-31) for general pathology consultation (PATHC), **not sarcoma-specific**: 4 to 8 days; the final pathology report may be delayed if additional materials are required, or if ancillary testing (up to 21 days) is indicated . 5. Report released directly to the patient?

VERIFIED (2026-07-31) — yes, via authorization, not by phone.

- MCL: only reports for tests performed at Mayo Clinic Laboratories can be released; reports can be sent to another provider for continuing care at no charge, or to the patient personally with charges applying ; complete the Authorization to Release Protected Health Information form and return it (mail: Mayo Clinic Laboratories, Attn: MLI, PO Box 4100, Rochester, MN 55905); form questions **507-284-3050** . <https://www.mayocliniclabs.com/customer-service/contacts>

Medical oncology — **VERIFIED (2026-07-31)**: Mahesh Seetharam, M.D., hematologist-oncologist at Mayo Clinic in Phoenix, Arizona, Consultant in Hematology/Oncology ; <https://www.mayoclinic.org/biographies/seetharam-mahesh-m-d/bio-20308505> (sarcoma focus itself is **UNVERIFIED** on the Mayo bio text retrieved; non-Mayo profile states he specializes in bone and soft tissue sarcoma and skin cancers). Surgical (orthopedic oncology) — **VERIFIED**: Krista A. Goulding, M.D., M.P.H., orthopedic surgeon at Mayo Clinic Arizona specializing in patients with sarcomas and other tumors of the musculoskeletal system ; <https://www.mayoclinic.org/biographies/goulding-krista-a-m-d/bio-20440944>

Sarcoma pathologist at the Arizona campus — **UNVERIFIED**: no named AZ bone/soft-tissue pathologist confirmed. Verified adjacent: Mayo's named bone and soft tissue pathology faculty are in Rochester — Jorge Torres-Mora, M.D. (program director), Andrew Folpe, M.D., Judith Jebastin Thangaiyah, M.B.B.S., M.D., Carrie Inwards, M.D., Jeremy F. Molligan, M.D., Andre M. Sarcoma tumour board — **UNVERIFIED for the Arizona campus specifically**. Mayo CPD lists a sarcoma tumour board: a weekly hour-long videoconference (tumor board) connecting multiple sarcoma centers nationally to review pathology, imaging and histories of challenging cases and reach a consensus treatment plan <https://ce.mayo.edu/sarcoma-conference-2019> — campus/current status not confirmed; verify on **480-301-8484** or **480-515-6296**.

Suggested single call order: referring pathologist calls **480-301-8021** (final reports) → **480-301-6185** (non-billing) → **800-533-1710** if MCL-routed; family separately files ROI via **507-284-4594**. No number above is guessed; all are quoted from live Mayo pages/forms as of 2026-07-31.
